PROPERTY HIGHLIGHTS

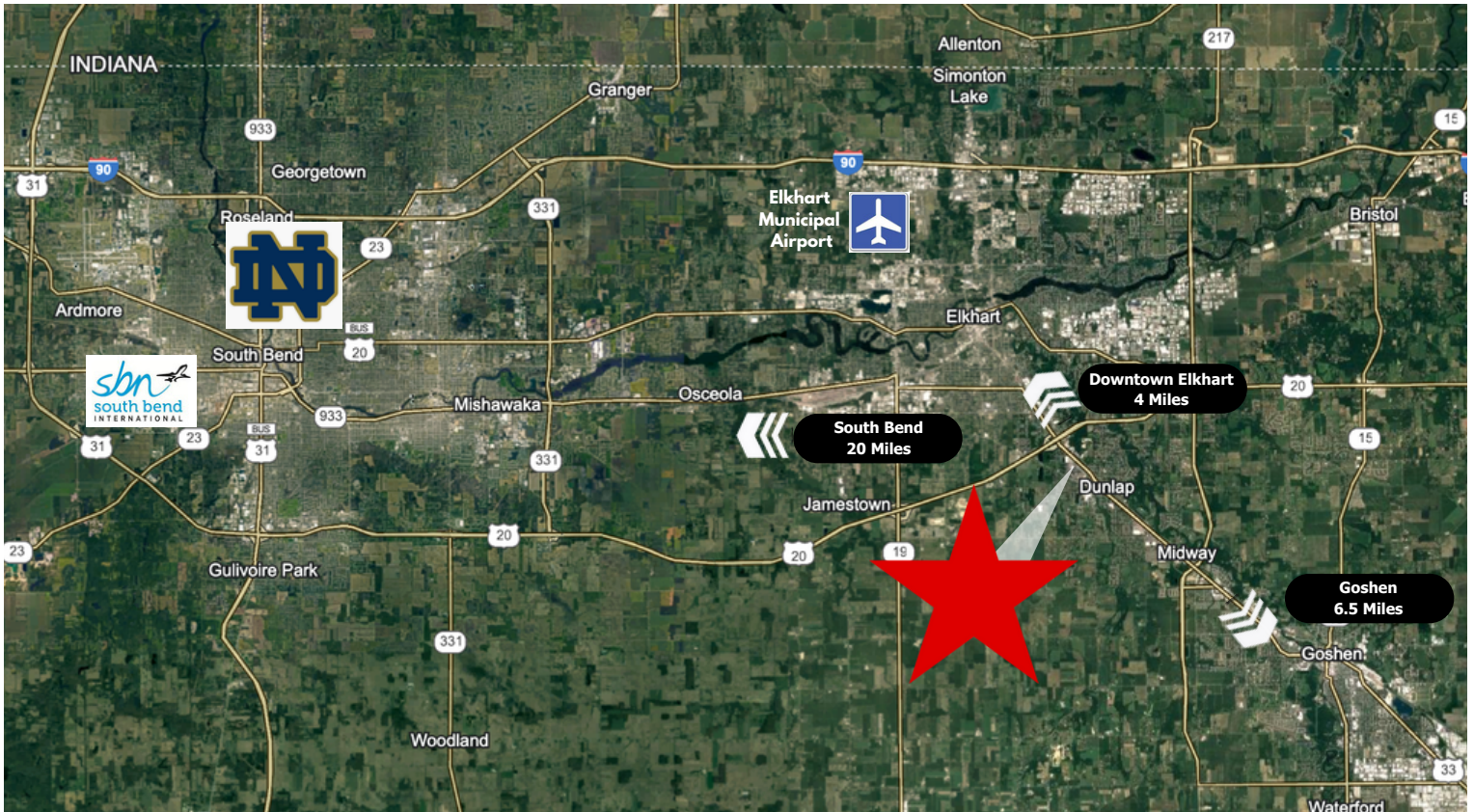
- The former Concord Mall in Elkhart, IN is undergoing a complete transformation and redevelopment to become Elkhart's new and up and coming development

- Centrally located in the City of Elkhart with new roadway access onto S. Main St (Rte. 33) and immediate access to Highway 20. Under 10 miles to the I-80/90 toll road

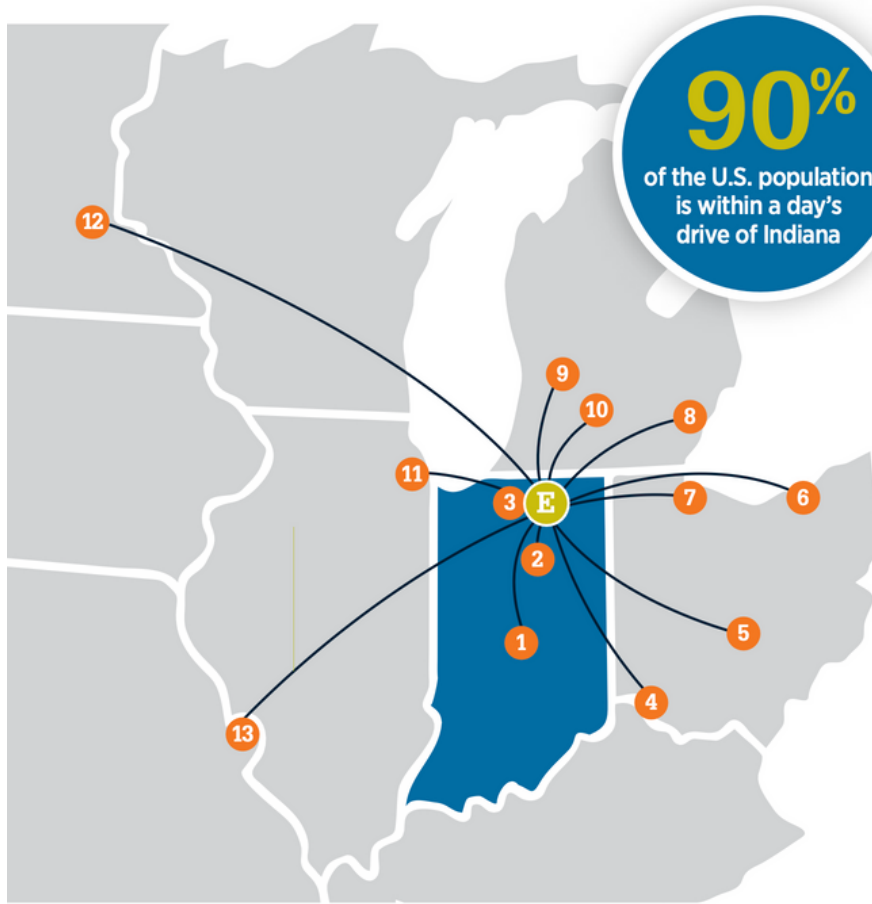

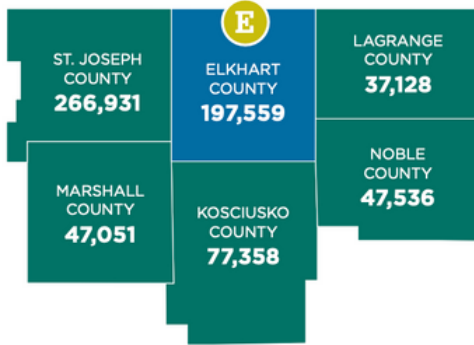

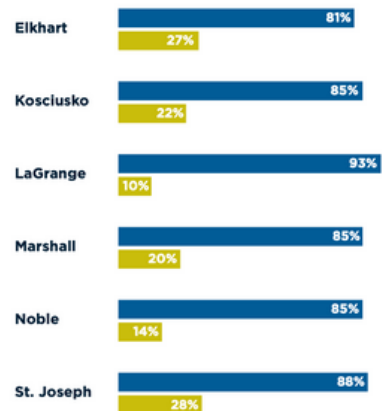
